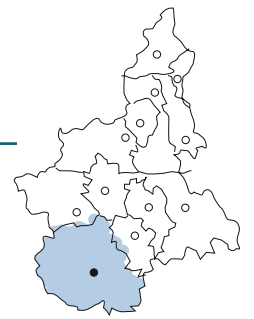

CUNEO AND ITS VALLEYS:

a crossroads of history and nature



For the Mind and Body at High Altitude

Sulphur and thermal springs bubble to the earth's surface in Terme di Valdieri, situated in the heart of the Maritime Alps National Park, where a stroll through the botanical gardens opens up unforgettably spectacular views on the majestic peaks, dominated by the Argentera massif. Catch a more in-depth glimpse into the natural Cuneo environment in all its forms at the education and exhibition centre of Villa Bianco.

Vernante takes to Pinocchio

Take an entertaining walk through the story of Pinocchio, thanks to 90 murals depicting the original illustrations of the first edition of Collodi's classic tale, painted by Attilio Mussino, who himself adopted Vernante as his home.

Suspended between Italy and France Limone, one of the region's leading ski

resorts and an important reservoir of the vestiges of times past. Take a stroll through the winding streets of the town centre to the Parish Church of Saint Peter in Chains, an outstanding example of gothic architecture in Piedmont, and to the Town Hall, which features a stunning sixteenth-century, four-spout stone fountain in its adjacent square.

City of Cuneo

The capital of Italy's largest province, Cuneo has been a crossroads for traders and cultures since deep in history, or more precisely 1198, when the town was first founded. A leisurely walk through the city's 8km of porticoes, filled with shops stocked to the brim with typical products from the area, including the famous chocolates cuneesi al rhum, will take you to see the Church of Saint Francis, the Civic Museum, and the Cathedral, all of which can be visited. The Town Hall, which is also an event venue, is definitely worth a visit.

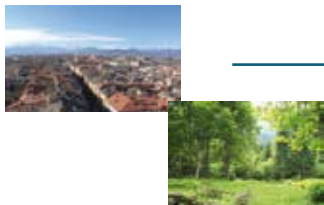
